The Southeastern Pennsylvania Symphony Orchestra (formerly the North Penn Symphony Orchestra) is a regional professional orchestra and enters its 39<sup>th</sup> season and ninth year under internationally noted Music Director Allan R. Scott. The concert season typically includes five to six subscription concerts and some non-subscription concerts. A regional professional orchestra, the Southeastern Pennsylvania Symphony Orchestra generally has two to four rehearsals the week of the concert series.

The Southeastern Pennsylvania Symphony Orchestra is a regional professional orchestra that works under a yearly contract. There are 2-4 rehearsals per concert series the week of the concert series.

In order to exist as an orchestra of the highest quality, the Southeastern Pennsylvania Symphony Orchestra encourages talented and dedicated musicians to audition. Musicians are judged on musicianship, preparation, tone quality, and proficiency on their instrument.

The Audition Committee consists of the Music Director and principal members of the section(s) or instrument family (i.e. winds), and at times, other members from that section. Prior to the audition, the candidate must complete the Audition Information Form as well as review the Musician Handbook and the rehearsal and performance schedule for the season.

If accepted into the Orchestra, the musician signs an agreement indicating their intention to commit to the season, the personnel policies, as well as make known any conflicts in the schedule.
